BRINGING HOME MORE GOLD

ALLEN, TX: The city of Tyler played host to the Rose City Classic, an invitational gymnastics competition attended by athletes from Eagle's Wings Athletics (EWA) and other gyms around the state, and even as far away as Colorado. Girls, coaches and families descended on the Patriot Center at UT Tyler March 13-15 for a fun and challenging weekend.

EWA's Level 10 team took second place in the team competition. Jessica Howe was the Junior B all-around champion with a score of 37.85. She also won gold on balance beam (9.7) and floor exercise (9.525), silver on uneven parallel bars (9.275), and bronze on vault (9.35). Emma Sibson won vault with a 9.625. Makenzie Johnson competed in the Junior C division, tying for first place on floor exercise (9.425), and earning second on vault (9.45) and third on beam (9.0). In the Junior A group, Nickie Guerrero won bronze all-around (36.75) with second place

on both floor (9.475) and bars (8.825). Tia Allbritten took third place on the balance beam with a score of 9.45.

The level 8 team also took second place in the team awards. Korinne Manjarres won the all-around in the Junior C group, earning 38.55 total. She placed first on bars (9.725) and vault (9.575), second on floor (9.55) and third on beam (9.7). Emily Howe earned second place all-around (38.425), with first place wins on beam (9.75) and floor (9.7), and a second place score on vault (9.525). Haylee Roe took silver on balance beam with a 9.725.

In the Level 8 Junior A group, Heather Udowitch and Cori Guerrero both scored a 9.8 for gold - Heather on the bars and Cori on the beam. They tied for second place on floor exercise with a 9.625. Heather also took a silver medal on vault (9.6) and bronze all-around (38.325). In the Senior A division, Tiffany James earned second place on balance beam (9.55) and all-around (37.575).

Jordan Williams was the Level 7 Junior A all-around champion, earning a total of 38.65. She also won gold on vault (9.8) and bars (9.625). Junior B Elizabeth Ritchie took first place on uneven bars (9.825) and vault (9.775), and second on floor (9.75) and all-around (38.4). Cambry Lohmann was the beam champion in the Junior C group, earning 9.65. She also placed

second on floor exercise (9.55) to take second all-around (38).
These three girls earned the second place Level 7 team award.

The USA Gymnastics team at EWA is coached by Alex Atamas,
Virginia Oas, Amber Prather and head coach Tatiana Schegolkova.
