BUSY WEEKEND FOR EWA GYMNASTS

ALLEN, TX: It was another busy weekend for athletes from Eagle's Wings Athletics as they traveled near and far to perform their skills, impress judges, and outscore their competitors.

BOYS TEAM SPINS IN AUSTIN

The boy's team, despite having a few members scratch the meet due to illness, came home with some surprise wins from the Spinners Invitational in Austin. Gavin McCallister won the all-around in the Level 4, age 6-7 group with a 89.60. He also placed first on high bar (15.5) and pommel horse/mushroom (14.7), second on vault (15.1) and tied for third on parallel bars (14.7) with teammate Logan Cobb. Logan also took second on high bar (15.3) and all-around (89.3). They joined two teammates to earn a first place team trophy.

Five boys competed in the Level 5, age 7-8 group, which also won the first place team trophy. Carter Frederick was the parallel bars champion (14.7), Landon Smith took third on still rings (15.1) and Nicholas Brocklesby earned third place on high bar (15.0).

Bradley Weatherford won two events for the Level 5, age 10-11 division. He took gold on vault (15.1) and floor exercise (14.9). Cole Carter won third place on floor (14.3) and all-around (84.3). The team won second place in the age 10+ group.

Level 6 Drew Huck, age 10, won the parallel bars (14.8) and rings (14.3), and took second on pommel horse/mushroom (15.2) to earn silver all-around (86.6). The four boys in the age group earned a second place team award.

Evan Fitzgerald, in the Level 9 age 12 and over division, took gold on vault (13.4), tied for gold on parallel bars (12.7), and took silver on pommel horse (12.3) to get bronze all-around (71.3). Level 10 Johann Handszer was the high bar champion (11.8) in the age 14-15 group, and earned third on both parallel bars (13.1) and still rings (9.2).
