EWA WINS AT STATE MEETS

ALLEN, TX: The USA Gymnastics teams at Eagle's Wings Athletics (EWA) were busy the weekend of March 28-29 as the boy's team hosted the Level 4 and 5 North State Championship, and the Level 10 girl's team traveled to Coppell to compete in the State Championship.

EWA's Level 10 girl's team won first place out of nine teams in the small team division. Teams of five girls or less entered a competition to have their top three scores on each event count toward a team total. EWA's winning total was 113.400, while the second place team had a score of 111.800.

Jessica Howe had the highest all-around of the five EWA girls. She took third place in the Junior B division with a total score of 37.7, after having tied for third on

balance beam (9.625), and earning third on uneven parallel bars (9.425), and seventh on vault (9.3). In the same division, Emma Sibson took silver on vault (9.675), tied for ninth on floor exercise (9.45), and placed seventh all-around (37.025).

In the younger Junior A division, Tia Allbritten tied for fourth place in both the all-around (37.425) and on uneven bars (9.125). She also took sixth place on balance beam with a 9.65, and scored 9.325 on vault and floor exercise. Nickie Guerrero placed eighth on vault (9.5) and tenth on balance beam (9.45), and earned a 9.4 on floor.

Makenzie Johnson competed in the Junior C division, where she took bronze on vault with a 9.625. She also placed sixth on floor exercise (9.525) and tied for seventh on balance beam (9.5) to place sixth in the all-around (37.475).

Each girl qualified to go to the Regional Championships held in Denver in April, where they will go up against gymnasts from the seven states in Region 3 - Arkansas, Colorado, Kansas, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Texas and Wyoming. The EWA girls are coached by Head Coach Tatiana Schegolkova, Alex Atamas, Amber Prather and Virginia Oas.
