GYMNASTS ADVANCE TO NATIONALS

ALLEN, TX: Several teams from Eagle's Wings Athletics (EWA) competed in State meets recently, giving deserving athletes the opportunity to advance to the next level of competition.

EWA's Trampoline and Tumbling team hosted the North Texas State Championships at McKinney North High School March 14. At the meet, 26 EWA athletes qualified to advance to Nationals on at least one event.

Amy McDonald was the tumbling champion in the Senior Elite division. Josh Williams won second place in Junior Elite for tumbling and double mini.

In the 15 and over boys division, Nathan Vite was the champion on all three events - level 7 double mini and trampoline, and level 6 tumbling. Level 9 Brandon Wilson won gold on trampoline and silver on double mini. Bryan Bashrum was the level 7 tumbling champion and took third on level 8 double mini and trampoline.

The girls in the 15 and over division, Samantha Arnold was the champion on both level 10 trampoline and level 9 tumbling. Paige McKay won gold on level 6 tumbling, while level 8 Hannah Green took third on trampoline and tumbling. Sarah Stewart took bronze on level 7 double mini and trampoline.

Mary Rossi, a level 10 in the 12-14 age group, was the champion on all three events. Level 9 Ryan Frome won first place on trampoline and third on double mini. Sydney Wendt, also level 9, earned silver on trampoline and bronze in tumbling. Courtney Christison took second in level 8 tumbling.

Brian Schmidt, in the age 13-14 group, took first place on level 9 trampoline, and second on level 9 double mini and level 7 tumbling. John LePino earned third place in level 5 tumbling for ages 11 and 12. In the 9 and 10 year olds group, Ryan Allen won first place on all three events for level 7. Caden Kirby took second on level 7 double mini

and trampoline and level 6 tumbling. Level 6 Tyler Dunning won first on double mini and third on trampoline.

Three EWA girls competed in the age 11 and 12 division. Annika Cline was the level 8 tumbling champion and took second on level 7 double mini. Charlotte Pearce earned silver on level 6 trampoline, while Macy Levine took bronze in level 5 tumbling. Gaby Williams, level 6, won second on tumbling in the age 9 and 10 group.
