REGULAR SEASON WINDING DOWN

ALLEN, TX: Many of the competitive teams from Eagle's Wings Athletics are finishing up their regular season meets and gearing up for State competition. The men's gymnastics team competed in the Garland Classic Invite March 7, earning 3 team trophies, while the Level 7 gymnasts from the women's team competed at North State in Plano.

Gavin McCallister was the Level 4 age 6-7 all-around champion, with a total score of 90.90. He won gold on vault (15.4), silver on parallel bars (15.2) and pommel horse/mushroom (15.1), and bronze on still rings (15.4), and tied for fourth place on the other two events - high bar (15.0) and floor exercise (14.8). Logan Cobb tied with Gavin on the high bar, and earned fifth on pommel horse/mushroom and sixth on floor and rings, to take fifth

all-around (88.1). The Level 4 team earned a second place team trophy.

Several EWA boys competed in the Level 5, age 7-8 group. Landon Smith earned fifth on floor exercise (15.0) and fifth all-around (87.6). Nicholas Brocklesby tied for third on high bar (14.9), while Carter Frederick tied for fourth on pommel horse/mushroom. Carter tied with teammate Quinn Maloney for fifth place on the still rings. Quinn also tied for third on parallel bars (14.8) and took fifth on the high bar.

Kade Cummings, in the 9-year old group, took fourth on vault (14.85), fifth on high bar and rings, and sixth on floor, parallel bars, and all-around. In the age 10-11 group, Bradley Weatherford won silver on vault (15.3), and tied for fifth place on floor exercise. Also tying for fifth place was Karcen Raney on parallel bars and Cole Carter on floor. The Level 5 age 10 and over team earned a second place team trophy, while the age 7-9 boys earned third place team.

Cole Wilhelm was the pommel horse/mushroom champion in the Level 6 age 10-11 division with a score of 15.1. He took silver on floor (15.2) and high bar (14.9), and fourth on parallel bars and fifth all-around (86.35). Drew Sikora tied for fourth on vault and took fifth on parallel bars.

Evan Fitzgerald, Level 9, won gold on pommel horse (12.6), silver on rings (11.4), vault (13.5), parallel bars (12.1), high bar (11.4) and all-around (71.7), and bronze on floor (10.7).

Level 10 Johann Handszer was the all-around champion (71.7) in the age 14-15 group. He won golds straight across - floor (12.6), pommel horse (11.3), rings (12.5), vault (13.4), parallel bars (9.8), and high bar (11.1). Brothers Chris and Justin Muenz took the top two spot in the age 16-18 all-around group. Chris took first (72.5), and won floor (13.0), vault (13.3) and tied for first on parallel bars (11.5) with Justin. Chris also won silver on pommel horse (11.8) and bronze on rings (11.5) and high bar (11.4). Justin won pommel horse (12.5) and took second place on floor (12.1), vault (12.7), high bar (12.2), and all-around (70.2).
