USAG WOMEN AT WOGA CLASSIC

The USA Gymnastics team competed at the Frisco Conference Center, where Cori Guerrero and Korinne Manjarres led the Level 8 team to a first place win. They both got a first place all-around score of 37.95, Cori's in the Junior A division and Korinne's in Junior B. Cori also was the balance beam champion (9.7) and vault champion (9.35), and she tied for third on floor exercise (9.6). Korinne won the balance beam with a 9.85, and tied for bronze on floor (9.55). Junior A Arynne Dugan was the floor exercise champion (9.75), while Emily Howe, Junior B, won the vault (9.4) and took second on beam (9.675) and third on bars (9.6).

The Level 7's won the second place team award. In the Junior B division, Paige Williams tied for second place on both bars (9.7) and beam (9.575), and took third on vault (9.7) to win silver all-around (38.5). Cassidy Keelen tied for bronze on

floor exercise (9.8). In the Junior A group, Jordan Williams earned second place on uneven bars (9.7), while Elizabeth Ritchie tied for third on vault (9.8).

Jessica Howe was the Level 10 Junior uneven parallel bars champion with a score of 9.525. Emma Sibson placed third on vault (9.425) and Makenzie Johnson took third on uneven bars (9.3). EWA's Level 10 team, with only 3 girls competing all events, won the third place team award. To calculate the team award, the top three scores from each team on each event are totaled. The first place team had 19 athletes to choose from, the second place team had 6.
